Appointment of Deputy Centre Manager

In April, the Trustees announced that they had decided to strengthen the Centre management team and would be seeking a Deputy Centre Manager as a matter of priority. They are now pleased to announce the appointment of Teresa Lucey to that position. She will join us on 9 July.

Teresa is an experienced manager and joins us from Cambridge County Council where, as Safeguarding Trainer, she developed and delivered a range of courses for volunteers, GPs and professional social workers. She delivered a Safeguarding course for CCHC Trustees and volunteers last year.

Before that, she worked for South Cambridgeshire District Council as Homelessness Officer leading a team working on housing projects, dealing with tenants and assessing homelessness applications.

Teresa will work closely with Azra to ensure that all aspects of the running of the Centre are dealt with effectively whilst, at the same time, ensuring more time is available to support members.

Her appointment will also create the headroom needed to pursue opportunities for growth as well as providing greater strength-in-depth to ensure that the Centre can operate fully and effectively at all times, particularly during holidays and times of sickness.
